
#### **CITIZENSHIP**

During the period April-June 2024, in the Department of Citizenship, a total of 271 decisions on Relinquishment from citizenship were rendered: 260 positive d., 11 negative d. and 232 requests.






### TEMPORARY RECEPTION CENTRE FOR MIGRANTS

During the period April -June 2024, a total of 129 migrants were accommodated in the Temporary Reception Centre for Migrants, which 124 (96 %) of them are men and 5 (4%) are women.

From the description of the data in the table, we see that the largest number of migrants is from Morocco 71 (78%) followed from Syria with 19 (15%), Palestine 13 (10%) by Algeria 12 (9%), Egypt 8 (6%), Pakistan 2 (2%), Iraq 1 (0, 7%) Libya 1 (%), Guinea 1(0, 7%) and Cameroon 1(0, 7%).

### **DETENTION CENTER FOR FOREIGNERS**

During the period April-June 2024, a total of 10 foreigners were detained in the Detention Center for Foreigners, of which 4 were from Syria and 6 from Bangladesh.

With the annulment decision for banning, as brought forward by the DCF, 9 foreigners have left while 2 foreigners have escaped.

The number of people accommodated in the center during this period was 8 foreigners.

### **FOREIGNERS**

During the period April-June 2024, the number of requests for residence permits is 1,938, of which: men 1,138 (59%) and women 800 (41%);

- Requests for temporary residence permits are 1,830, men 1,079 (59%) and women 751 (41%), of which 919 are for the first time and 911 are ongoing;
- The number of requests for permanent residence permits are 108, men 59 (55%) and women 49 (45%), of which 35 are for the first time and 73 are ongoing.







### **RE-ADMISSION AND RETURN**

During the period April-June 2024, 160 persons readmitted from different countries were returned in the border points – forced - 146 (91%), Volunteers 5 (3%) and Volunteers assisted by IOM 9 (36%).
